The use of names or addresses derived from public records for commercial purposes is expressly prohibited under Kansas law (K.S.A. 45-230).

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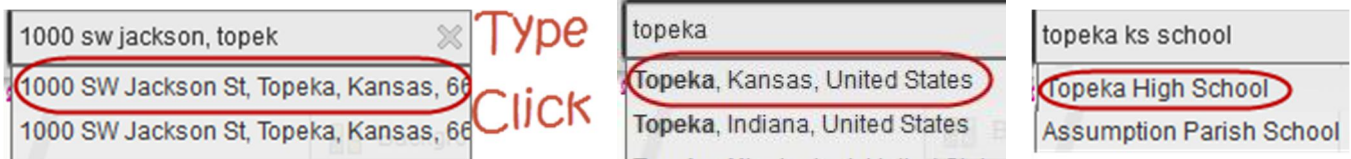
A. Search for Location on Map:

1. Address or Place:



An “Enter Address” box is located in the upper left corner of the map.

- Start typing an address, city, zip code, or another name in the box.
- A list of suggested matches will appear if a match is found.
- Click on one of the matches to zoom to that location on the map.



2. Manual Zoom using Navigation bar or mouse scroll:


- Mouse:
 - Use the mouse scroll wheel to zoom in and out of the map
 - Use the mouse pointer click and drag to pan in any direction.
- Navigation Control Tools: located at the upper left corner of the map.

- Click  or  to zoom in or out



- The more criteria you add, the smaller the set of chosen facilities will be

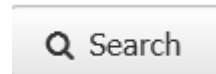


- Click the  button to complete the search

- All facilities that match the search criteria will be indicated on the map with a purple circle









C. Export or Hide List of Solid Waste Facilities

3. The list can be hidden by clicking the  at the top of the list.

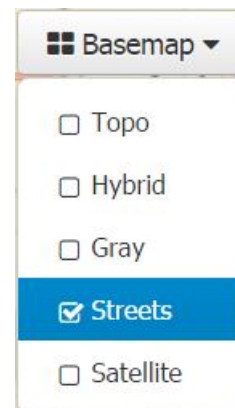
D. Solid Waste Facility Information:

- Click on a map symbol to see a pop-up identifying the facility.
- Many points may be located at or near the same location. There will be a scroll option with arrows at the upper left of the pop-up.
- Inside the pop-up will be hyperlinks to more information about that facility.




E. Backgrounds/Basemaps

F. Print Maps

- If you cannot see the “Print” box on the left side of the map, collapse the “Search” and “Layers” boxes by clicking on the triangles.
- You can now choose the settings, formatting, etc. that you want for the map.

For a map of closed city dumps, click on the link to that map



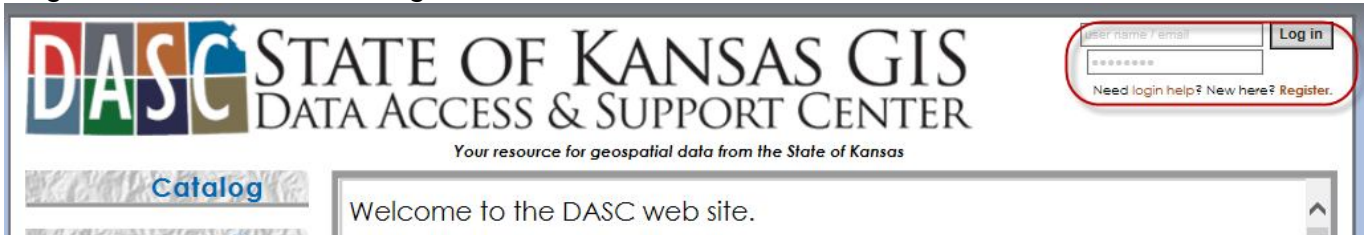
H. About

I. Download Entire Database and Spatial Data

On a nightly basis, KDHE replicates the KDHE Solid Waste Database to **DASC** – the State of Kansas GIS Data Access & Support Center. To obtain the Geospatial Data.

1. Open <http://www.kansasgis.org/>
2. Register for a user name / login



3. Click the “Catalog” tab on the left panel
4. Either use the “Search” tab and search for KDHE or under “Environmental Resources” category, click on “Solid Waste Disposal”.



5. Click on the “File Downloads” tab in the center of the Right Panel.
